Altima campaign also helps athletes lower risk of concussion

Brockville, Ontario: A properly-fitted mouthguard may be the smallest piece of hockey equipment, but it can be one of the most important. Mouthguards prevent and reduce injury to an athlete's mouth and brain. Starting September 9, hockey players in Brockville (and across Ontario) will be able to visit Altima 1000 Islands Dental Centre or Altima Parkedale Dental Centre and get fitted for a custom mouthguard designed in their team's colours.

"Mouthguards act like a cushion, helping to absorb the impact of a blow more evenly," said Dr. George Christodoulou, Altima Dental Canada President and co-CEO. "Not only do they lower the risk of broken teeth, but they also play a role in preventing concussions. Every hockey player should wear a custom-fitted mouthguard."

Research indicates that pressure-laminated mouthguards can protect against concussions by reducing shock to the head, neck and teeth (Journal of Athletic Training, 2001). Athletes who do not wear a mouthguard are almost twice as likely to suffer a dental injury compared to those who do wear one (Sports Medicine, 2007).

Health Canada, the Canadian Dental Association and the Canadian Academy of Sports Medicine recommend wearing a custom-fitted mouthguard during activities that present a risk of dental injury or concussion. A single blow to the mouth may result in months or even years of treatment, with costs ranging from hundreds to thousands of dollars. Typically custom-fitted mouthguards can cost about \$250 each.

Aside from the safety advantages, custom-fitted mouthguards may also improve athletic performance. There is evidence that having a properly-aligned jaw improves body posture (Neuroscience Letters, 2004) which can increase balance, endurance and strength. A custom-fitted mouthguard could move the jaw into its optimal position, relaxing facial muscles and improving oxygen flow - factors that could maximize athletic performance.

Altima Smartguards mouthguards are made from pressure-laminated layers of European plastic, each shaped separately over a mould of the user's teeth. Dentists recommend pressure-laminated mouthguards because of their fit, protection and comfort.
