

SHIRT POLICY

We need something in place to protect ourselves and the BMHA for lost and damaged equipment.

Shirts will be handed out to each individual team.

It will be the responsibility of these teams to maintain and care for the shirts.

If a team chooses to send the shirts home with individual players, then they must be on a hanger at all times, and in garment bags. Shirts are not to be left in hockey bags.

The team and the players must sign off on a shirt contact and have the forms returned to your divisional convener.

At the end of season when shirts are to be returned, Shirts must be washed and returned in the team bags.

Shirts will then be inspected by the division convener and equipment manager. If shirts are not returned or are mistreated and unable to be used for future hockey. The player will then be responsible for the replacement of the set of shirts (\$150.00).

Shirts must be returned by the 1st week end in April. A drop off time will be announced at the end of season.

Player's names will not be allowed to be sewn on the shirts. The only attachments that will be placed on shirts will be Sponsor's name bars and A's & C's.

The BMHA will be responsible for the sewing of the sponsorship bars. Any removal of sponsorship bars will be the responsibility of the BMHA.

If at any time a player refuses to pay for damaged shirts then they will be considered not in good standing with the BMHA and will not be allowed to register until such payment is made.
