

Clinic Refund Policy

The development of the BMHA hockey player is very important. We need to be able to provide each player with the best possible instruction we can. In order for this to happen the BMHA must ensure that all of its associated coaches and trainers are properly trained. Each of these people must be properly educated and trained through proper clinics

The B.M.H.A will refund a maximum of \$3000.00 each year in clinic fees.

The B.M.H.A will not pay for and transportation or other costs incurred by these clinics.

The B.M.H.A will reimburse the cost of their clinic up to \$200.00. Each participant must be on a team registered roster of a B.M.H.A team before having a refund issued.

The B.M.H.A will re-reimburse a limited number of coaches each year for participating in either the Intro to coach clinic, Trainers 1 Clinic, Coach Stream Clinic or Developmental 1 Clinic.

Specialty clinics can be brought forth in an application to the executive board for consideration and approval.

The B.M.H.A will not reimburse for the Speak out Clinic, Trainers 2 recertification, any First Aid or CPR courses.

No person can apply for more than 1 clinic per hockey season.

It is the responsibility of the Coaches must apply for these clinic refunds.

If an applicant is not on a Team registered roster then they cannot be considered for a clinic refund. BUT, the applicant can re-apply for the refund if they become registered on a team roster for up to 1 year.

A valid and readable receipt must be presented to the B.M.H.A executive before a refund can be issued.
